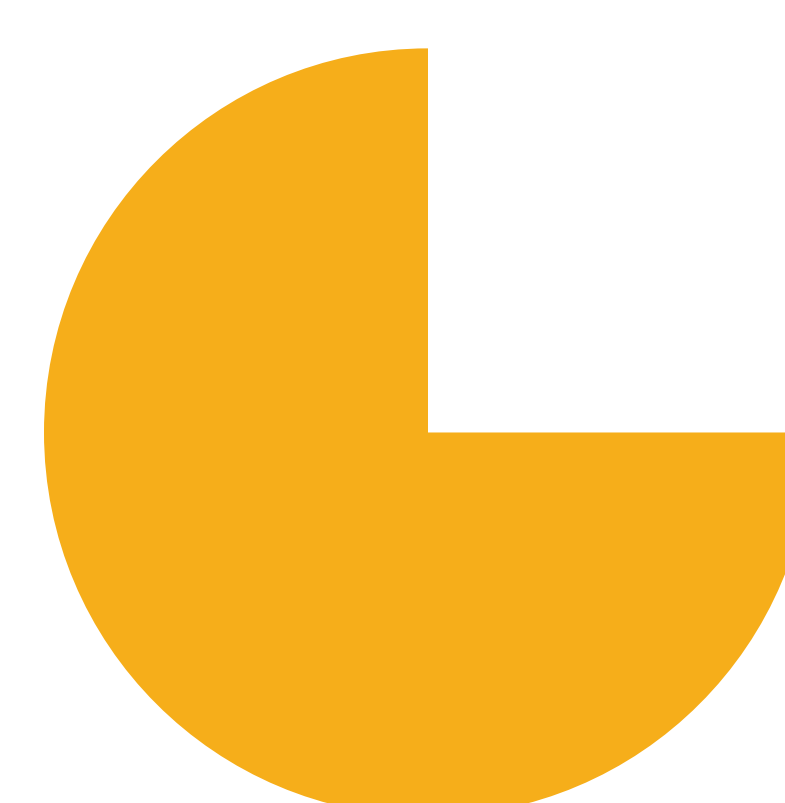

Mental Health



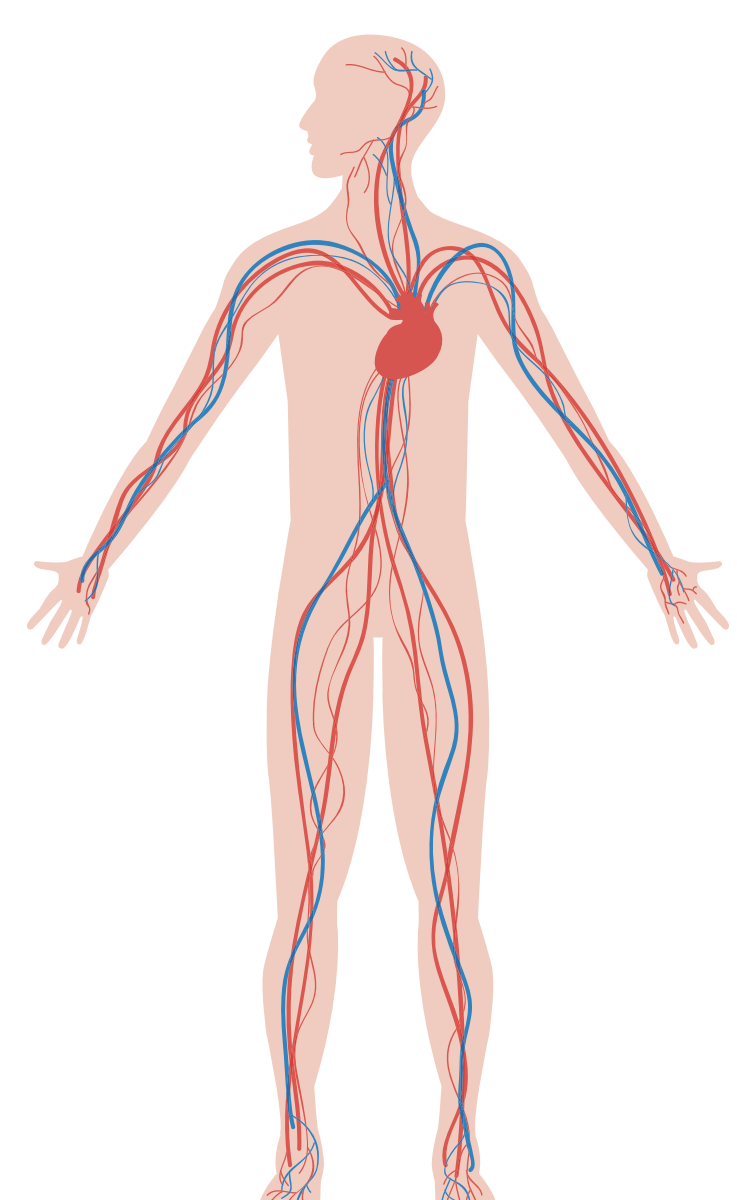
24 of 25 counties **do not have**
