### **Abstract Components**

- 1) Background information of your project
- 2) Evidence used to identify the need
- 3) Improvement aims or goal
- 4) Methods, programs, or practices description
- 5) Outcomes and data description
- 6) Conclusion

### **Requirements**

- › All abstracts must include one to five referenced (APA style) pieces of evidence within the past five (5) years.
- › Abstracts should contain original work.
- › Work that is in progress can also be submitted; please include expected outcomes. Preference is given to completed work.

### **Presentation**

- › Selected abstracts will be presented in one of two ways:
  - **Podium Presentation:** An allotted 20-minute time slot (15-minute presentation with 5 minutes for questions)

- **Poster Presentation:** Posters will be displayed during the Symposium, with dedicated poster sessions scheduled
- › Please indicate in the abstract submission survey your preference.

*To support professional development, TNEC will have coaches available to assist staff nurses with accepted abstracts with their presentation preparation.*

### **Due Date**

- › Abstracts must be submitted electronically no later than **November 1, 2023.**
- › Late submissions will not be accepted.

### **Acceptance notification**

- › Authors will be notified about their submission status via email no later than November 30, 2024.
- › All poster and podium presenters will be required to complete a Conflict-of-Interest form as part of the continuing education requirements. All presenters must be registered for the conference to present and are responsible for their own registration expenses; registration information to follow.

### **Materials**

- › For podium presentations: a laptop and projector/screen will be provided.
- › For poster presentations:
  - › Posters may be printed on presenters' choice of medium.
  - › Posters should be oriented in landscape format and no larger than 48W X 36H.
  - › Presenters are responsible for bringing all materials necessary to display your poster.
  - › Tables are provided for trifold boards. Space is available for easel setup.

  1. Podium or Poster Presentation
  2. Podium Only

#### **Improvement/ Innovative Initiative Details**

*Instructions: Please complete each of the following sections, when applicable. Each section should contain between 50 and 1,000 characters.*

- › Background information of your project
- › Evidence used to identify the need
- › Aim of the improvement
- › Description of methods, programs or practices
- › Description of the outcomes, including data
- › Conclusion

#### **Evidence/ Literature References**

- › Provide 1-5 references used in your project. References must be within the past 5 years and written in APA style.
